







Figure 4 Frequency of reference to image elements.





Figure 2 *The character of visual districts and centers.*





Figure 3 The structure of major sequences.






Figure 6 The problems of existing centers and districts.




Figure 7 The problems of existing streets and ways.



Figure 8 The problems of visual connection.




Figure 9 Some visual opportunities.
